### RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HOSTEL

**All the students who are staying in the hostel are required to follow the following rules and regulations of the hostel:**

- 1. Ragging is strictly Prohibited:** Ragging in any form i.e. making unpleasant noise, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear of shame or an embarrassment to the new students whether by words, spoken or written or by an act which include teasing, abusing, playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students or asking the new students to do any act or to perform such things which such student will not in the ordinary course willingly to do is strictly forbidden. If anyone is found guilty of directly/indirectly involved or abetting in ragging he will be **punished/rusticated/expelled/suspended** from the College and also liable to prosecution in terms of the **Supreme Court of India decision on Writ Petition No. (C) 656/1998**. Ragging is now a crime. No one can feign ignorance of the law. Under the prohibition of ragging Act 1997 those who indulge in ragging can be punished. Jail for ragging is for period from **6 months to 10 years & fine up to Rs. 50,000/-**.
- 2. A student seeking admission to the hostel shall have to submit another affidavit along with his application for hostel accommodation that he is aware of the ragging law in this regard and agrees to abide by the punishment meted out if he is found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging. (AICTE Requirement)**
- 3.** Hostel rooms are equipped with basic furniture and fittings of appliances. Students occupying the room will sign the receipt of items in Inventory Register. He will be responsible to hand over the items in their original serviceable condition to hostel authorities while leaving the rooms on close of the academic session.
- 4.** Rough handling of dining hall furniture, room furniture or any furniture/property or fittings of the hostel is strictly forbidden. **If any individual or group is identified to have caused the damage, double the cost of the damaged property will be recovered from him/group.** Repetition of damage to the hostel property will result in expulsion from the hostel.
- 5.** The hostellers themselves are personally responsible to safeguard their belongings. They are advised not to keep large amounts of cash or valuables like gold ring,

costly wristwatch etc., in their rooms. They should also take care of their Purse, Calculators, Cell Phones, Lap tops, Computers and Books. In case of theft or loss of any item the hostel authorities/College will not be responsible for such loss. The hostellers are advised to keep their rooms, boxes, suitcases, etc., securely locked with good quality locks.

6. Hostellers are neither allowed to keep private electrical fittings (electric heater, electric oven, electric kettle, coil electric stove and etc.) provided in rooms. Unauthorized possession will lead to confiscation of the goods and fine rupees ten thousand.
7. **It is mandatory for students residing in the Hostel to join the mess attached to the hostel. Hostellers are required to dine in the dining hall. No hosteller is permitted to take food in the room except for those reported sick with prior permission of hostel warden.** Indoor cooking including making of tea/coffee in the rooms is strictly prohibited. The hostellers shall not waste food, electricity & water. Wastage of food is a national loss.
8. **Smoking publicly, Gambling in any form such as Playing Cards (even without money at stake), consumption of alcohol, use of drugs and narcotics and even possession of such things are prohibited. Anyone found indulging in the use of such things will not only be asked to vacate the hostel but also be rusticated from the college.**
9. Students are not allowed to stay in the hostel during the class hours unless the stay is unavoidable due to illness or any other valid reason. In such cases they should take the permission and communicate the information to the Warden in writing.
10. No students shall leave the hostel without prior permission of the hostel warden.
11. Use of any electrical appliance except table-lamp and mobile-charge, is prohibited.
12. No student shall remain absent from the hostel during night between 8.00 pm to 5.00 am unless he has obtained night out pass from the hostel warden. Night out permission to hostellers will be given weekends only if the request of the inmate has prior approval of the parents.
13. **Students requiring to attend wedding, other social functions and going outstation will require permission of the Principal and Warden, subject to written application for the same from the students.**
14. Hostellers are not allowed to go outside from the campus during class.
15. Students having any Chronic/Communicable disease are not allowed to stay in hostel. Hostellers falling sick or feel symptoms of sickness should report to hostel warden for evacuation to hospital.
16. Parents/Guardian/Visitors can meet their ward in hostel with the prior permission of the hostel warden before **7.00 pm. No male visitor except parent is allowed to enter inside the Girls' Hostel and No female visitor except parent is allowed to enter inside the Boys' Hostel.**
17. Discussion on ladies, politics and religion is completely forbidden in the hostel &

mess.

18. No notice will be displayed by hostel inmates in the College/hostel notice board without the counter signature of hostel warden.
19. Taking part directly/indirectly in any movement or agitation or strike of students in the institute for any reason whatsoever will attract punishment, rustication or expulsion, which in the opinion of the management/Principal is subversive to the discipline of the College.
20. The College/Hostel authorities will conduct surprise checks periodically and if anyone is found violating the above rules, disciplinary action will be taken against him. The hostel rooms are subject to inspection by the College/Hostel authorities to make sure that they are kept neat and tidy and no unauthorized item like liquor, drugs, lethal weapons etc., are kept in the room.
21. Day scholars/guests are not allowed to spend night at hostel without permission of hostel warden except on special case. Lights and fan are to be switched off when no one is in the room.
22. Students shall be required to make their rooms available whenever required for repairs, maintenance, disinfections by designated inspectors and shall be required to vacate the room when leaving for Vacations/ Holidays.
23. Engaging personal attendants and keeping pets by a student in the hostel are not permitted.
24. **Any misuse of light and fan at any room are strictly prohibited and found, the respective students will be fined an amount of Rs. 500 instantly.**
25. No students are allowed to change their allotted room at any circumstances. If any student is found violating the same shall be fined Rs. 5000 instantly.
  - All the above rules are subject to change with respect to time without any prior notification.

I hereby state that the hostel facility is essentially required by me. I have read the hostel rules and I undertake to pay all dues for the use of hostel/mess from time to time and shall abide by the rules and regulations of the BBEC hostel and of BBEC campus as notified by competent authorities.
